- Drop off bottles and Registration forms at the Fair Office, or at 99 Bottles Winery or Old Bank Winery during their regular hours, OR, deliver to: 2210 Jewell Ave., Britt, IA
- Contestants may enter more than one bottle in a category. (mark, "1" "2" etc.)
- Entries will be judged on Appearance 3 pts; Aroma 6 pts; Taste 6 pts; Aftertaste 3 pts; Overall Impression, including bottle and cork 2 pts. (UC DAVIS 20 point system)
